Day One:


Day Two:

Day Three:

After breakfast this morning, a guide will collect you from the hotel for a full day private guided Cape Point Tour.



Cape Point Tour:

While driving via the False Bay coastline you will pass through Cecil John Rhodes's cottage, St James and the fishing hamlet of Kalk Bay. Stop to visit the resident Jackass Penguin colony at Boulders beach, one of the prettiest beaches on the peninsula with big granite boulders and azure waters. Continue along the coastal route to the Cape of Good Hope – the most south-westerly tip of Africa, where the cold Benguela and warm Mozambique currents meet. The landscapes at Cape Point are dramatic and the sea wild. Return to Cape Town via scenic Chapman's Peak drive, a winding cliff-hanging road carved into the mountainside.

GRANDE ROCHE

Grande Roche is situated in the scenic town of Paarl in the heart of the Cape Winelands. Paarl is the perfect base for the many attractions of the Cape Peninsula, for exploring the rugged West Coast or the whale watching look-outs of the Hermanus coastline. For your accommodation, eighteen terrace suites are dotted around the estate, some set in the vineyards, all with thatched roofs and shutters in keeping with the architectural character. Trailing vines overhang private terraces that have spectacular views of the vineyards and valleys surrounding the hotel.

Full Day Winelands Sightseeing Tour

Head off to one of the Cape's first farming districts – Paarl. The town is set at the foot of the cluster of remarkable granite domes from which it takes its name. Your first stop of the morning will be at one of the beautiful wineries in the area. An informative cellar tour and wine tasting gives visitors personalized insight into the finer points of wine-making. Proceed to the town of Franschoek, historically dating back to the 17th century when the French Huguenots arrived.

Billed as the Gourmet Capital of South Africa, this charming town, retains a French Huguenot style. Franschoek complements the artistry of its chefs and winemakers with the breathtaking beauty of its setting. You will enjoy a wine tasting at one of the numerous wine estates in the area, before taking time to enjoy the fabled culinary skills of the chefs at one of the many award winning restaurants. Onward to Stellenbosch, the heart of the South African Wine Industry, boasting great beauty and culture that is steeped in South African history. Walk down the canal-lined avenues, in the shade of giant oak trees and beautifully preserved historic buildings. Coffee shops, galleries, antique shops and wine bars spill onto the sidewalks. An air of quiet intellectualism and wine-making history abounds in this university town.

Singita

Singita, meaning 'the Miracle' in the local Shangaan language - is exquisite luxury, rare solitude and perfect tranquillity in a jewel-like setting where dedicated, professional staff seek to pamper and please you. World-class comfort, style, food and rare vintage wines stroke the senses and exclusive accommodation for the discerning traveller.

Day Nine & Ten:

After senses are awakened by the sounds of the bushveld, you will congregate with the rangers at the main lodge for tea, coffee and light snacks in anticipation of the early morning game drive. As the early morning sun rises over the horizon, rangers and trackers head out with guests into the African bushveld. One can sense the excitement... who knows what to expect? The sound of creatures awakening to a new day stirs your passion for Africa and its many wonders.

The fresh aromas of Singita's signature breakfast entice you back to the lodge. Overlooking the African plains from the main deck, a spectacular breakfast follows your return from the morning game drive, with a buffet of seasonal fruits, cereals, yoghurts and fruit juice, followed by a delectable hot breakfast. At your leisure - whether an indulgent massage or beauty treatment at the spa, relaxing under an African sun on your sundeck, a workout at the gym or some superb shopping at the trading store, any number of discoveries await. After spending the morning at leisure, Singita's talented chefs prepare a medley of culinary delights for lunch, inspired by African flavours yet guided by western cooking tradition. As the endless African day starts to cool and the shadows are forming across the plains, you will enjoy afternoon refreshments, which are served in the main lodge before the evening game drive.
