Day One:

Singita Private Game Lodge

Boulders Lodge towers over the landscape, a monolith of curving thatch and piled stone that joins seamlessly with the rocky geometry that holds it to the earth. Senufo artefacts and bold sculpture offset smooth linen in blue and silent white, as cascading water cools the summer air. Boulders Lodge rests on the banks of the Sand River in the heart of the Singita Private Game Reserve, unlocking the senses to views that stretch to the edges of the imagination. Quiet, simple and luxurious, moments spent on the vast sundecks at Boulders Lodge will leave you at the mercy of the breathtaking wild distance.

Day Three & Four:

After senses are awakened by the sounds of the bushveld, you will congregate with the rangers at the main lodge for tea, coffee and light snacks in anticipation of the early morning game drive. As the early morning sun rises over the horizon, rangers and trackers head out with guests into the African bushveld. One can sense the excitement... who knows what to expect? The sound of creatures awakening to a new day stirs your passion for Africa and its many wonders.

The fresh aromas of Singita's signature breakfast entice you back to the lodge. Overlooking the African plains from the main deck, a spectacular breakfast follows your return from the morning game drive, with a buffet of seasonal fruits, cereals, yoghurts and fruit juice, followed by a delectable hot breakfast. At your leisure - whether an indulgent massage or beauty treatment at the spa, relaxing under an African sun on your sundeck, a workout at the gym or some superb shopping at the trading store, any number of discoveries await. One by one, the drivers return to the lodge, the fires are lit and the night's entertainment begins.

Return to the lodge for dinner around the fire in the Boma under a starlit sky, or a gourmet meal by candlelight in the dining room. A fusion of venison dishes, fresh fish from the South African coast, pastas, soups and vegetables, dinner at Singita is a sumptuous affair, where you will be enchanted by the rhythm and harmony of a local choir. 

Day Six:

Today you may choose to enjoy any of the activities that the Victoria Falls has to offer at an additional cost.

Elephant Back Safari:

Every one of these magnificent animals can offer a passage to adventurers, who rise to the wonder of discovery of the forests around the World Heritage Park. Thanks to expert Guides you will discover the elephant's willingness and intelligence to act under instruction and guide you through an area that accommodates giraffes, hippo, buffalo, antelopes, impala, zebra and small cats such as civet and servile, all in a natural environment while you are seated high above on the elephant's back. The ride itself is approximately one hour, the inter-action time spent with the elephants approximately three hours.





Canoe Safari:

A romantic way to enjoy the great Zambezi River - it is mild and placid while edging as close to the fast proximities of the cascades as you dare. The fauna and the vegetation offer incredible views for those who follow the current, in company of guides who know the area and game habits well. The tranquil heart of Africa lives here.

White Water Rafting:

For the adrenaline adventurers! One whirling and unforgettable experience along the route carved over the millennia from the Great Zambezi. The adventure is supported by the latest and most up-to-date safety equipment to ensure a safe and enjoyable trip. The Zambezi River is known worldwide as one of the best one-day white water rafting day trips anywhere in the world.





Microlighting:

The African microlight experience combines the thrill of flight and the opportunity to experience the beauty of Africa in the open cockpit of the microlight with the wind in your face. Enjoy a 15-Minute Flight over Victoria Falls and Zambezi River OR a 30-Minute Flight over Victoria Falls, Batoka Gorge, Zambezi River & Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park.

Bungee Jumping:

The highest commercial bridge jump in the world in the most spectacular setting! This must be the ultimate adrenaline rush, as you leap into space, free as a bird, saved from the swirling water below by the rebound of the cord, then hurtled upwards again at great speed. It's an indescribable feeling that will probably change your life!





Horse Trails:

Enjoy the African bush and the Zambezi River riding along the riverbanks on the back of a horse. Whether you are an experienced rider or a novice it is a very pleasant and peaceful way to see game and enjoy the birds and the ride. Animals are less disturbed by a person on a horse and it is quite possible to watch game at very close quarters. Experienced guides lead these trails and riders are put with friends or groups of similar riding abilities. There are 5-hour safaris, which begin in the morning and include tea, coffee, soft drinks and snacks.

Fishing:

The Zambezi is famous for one of the great freshwater game fish—The Tigerfish. Powerful, swift predators Tigerfish are a thrill to catch and require a great deal of skill. A half-day trip either begins at 06.30 ending at 13.30 or pick up is at 13.30 and drop off is at 18.30. Includes transfers, tea and coffee, full English breakfast, or lunch as applicable, soft drinks, beer and fishing tackle.





Royal Livingstone Salon:

Enjoy the peace and tranquillity of the mighty Zambezi River while having a luxurious outdoor body massage or sit back and enjoy the healing power of a magnificent foot massage while relaxing next to the swimming pool. You will be collected from the Vumbura Plains Airstrip and transferred by scenic game drive to camp where you will be assisted with check in for your two night stay.

Vumbura Plains Camp

Vumbura Plains Camp is a luxury camp situated to the north of Mombo, in a private concession bordering the Moremi Game Reserve in the extreme north of the Okavango Delta. The Vumbura Reserve offers both land and water activities in a park that has a wonderful variety of habitats and a great diversity of wildlife. The reserve offers an enormous traversing area.

The main activity at Vumbura Plains is game viewing in wonderful and varied countryside. Open Land Rovers allow close proximity to animals in the savannah and forested areas. Lion, Leopard, Elephant, cheetah and Buffalo along with all the plains animals ensures an excellent all round wildlife experience in a remote and private part of the Okavango. Birding too is great with large varieties and quantities. Walks, mekoro's and boating give Vumbura's guests the opportunity to enjoy Africa from a different perspective.

Day Eight:

Early this morning, head out on your morning safari drive in pursuit of the Okavango Delta Wildlife! Return to the lodge for breakfast and enjoy the remainder of the morning at leisure. After a leisurely lunch and siesta, enjoy high tea before your afternoon/evening safari drive. Dinner this evening is hosted by your camp manager!

Mombo Camp

Mombo Camp is situated on Mombo Island, adjoining the northern tip of Chief's Island, and is within the Moremi Game Reserve in the Okavango Delta in northern Botswana. The island is surrounded by open floodplains and the camp itself is largely built in and around the shade of some large mangosteen, ebony and fig trees - overlooking a wonderful floodplain teeming with game. The camp has nine luxuriously furnished tents, raised off the ground. The guests' rooms and connecting walkways that connect are up to two meters off the ground, allowing game to wander freely through the camp - but at the same time allowing for your safety. One often finds that animals take refuge under the rooms. The canvas rooms are spacious and well appointed and have en-suite facilities with an additional outdoor shower for those who enjoy a shower under the stars.

Day Ten:

Early this morning, head out on your morning safari drive in pursuit of the Okavango Delta Wildlife! Return to the lodge for breakfast and enjoy the remainder of the morning at leisure. After a leisurely lunch and siesta, enjoy high tea before your afternoon/evening safari drive. Dinner this evening is hosted by your camp manager!

Overnight stay at Mombo Camp in a luxury tented suite on a full board basis

Day Eleven:
